

COLLABORATION BETWEEN ITALY AND NORWAY

In 2009, the University of Pisa and the University of Agder signed an agreement of collaboration in order to enhance relations between the two universities and develop academic and cultural interchange in the areas of education, research and other activities within mental health and psychosocial work. The agreement emerged from a longer collaboration between user-organisations and mental health practitioners in the two countries. The collaboration was extended and strengthened by an Erasmus agreement in 2011.

As the first concrete result of our collaboration, we are proud to launch a new book synthesizing reflections on “Interactions, health and community”.
